REALFORM PROJECT SPACE

2003-2008 | 45 exhibitions | 218 Bedford Avenue, Williamsburg, Brooklyn

By the early 2000s, I had developed an active independent curatorial practice in Williamsburg, organizing exhibitions in alternative venues such as Planet Thailand and working with galleries and nonprofit spaces including Jack The Pelican Presents and Nurture Art. What I lacked was a foothold of my own. The opportunity came by happy accident: another curator who had been presenting exhibitions in a small display space on Bedford Avenue was giving it up to pursue more ambitious group projects. He handed me the keys.

I named it Realform Project Space after the Real Form Girdle Company, whose factory had once occupied the building. By the time I arrived, the building was experiencing a renaissance of its own. The ground-floor Minimimall brought together independent businesses including Verb Cafe, Spoonbill & Sugartown Books, Bedford Cheese Shop, Bedford Wines, and a record store. Realform became part of this informal community: neighboring businesses supported the project, and exhibition receptions spilled out from the tiny display space into the Minimimall's central public area.

The exhibition space itself was little more than a display window, approximately five by seven by two-and-a-half feet. From 2003 to 2008, I organized 45 exhibitions there, particularly solo and small-group presentations. Its physical limitations encouraged concentration rather than spectacle, while its location exposed the work continuously to the life of Bedford Avenue. I later described Realform as 'the most public and most intimate of walls.'
